

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- NEVER allow unauthorized personnel to operate this product.
- NEVER use this product for anything other than its intended use.
- THOROUGHLY train new employees in the proper use and care of this product.
- PROHIBIT unauthorized personnel from being in shop area while this product is in use.

DEFINITIONS


- Before using this product, read and fully understand the operating instructions and all decals on the product. This is necessary to prevent injury to the operator and damage to the product.
- Use this product only for lifting, spreading and repairing tire casings. Do not use this product for any other purpose.
- Keep fingers and hands clear of spread hooks during tire spread.
- ♦ Do not use this product if it is visibly worn, distorted or damaged.
- Always wear appropriate eye protection.

AWARNING

- ♦ Keep feet clear of the tire ramp and scissor arms when raising and lowering spreader platform.
- All personnel must be clear of the tire lift area during operation.

INSTALLATION

- 1) Position the Model 5550 on a solid level floor, leaving adequate clearance to operate the machine.
- 2) Attach the ramp and ramp linkage to the front of the Model 5550. Use the supplied 3/8" bolts and lock nuts to attach the ramp to the brackets on the end of the platform. Slide the linkage rod through the linkages and mounts at the base of the unit with the linkages on the outside of the mounts. Place the supplied washer over the end of the rod and insert the cotter pin, bending the tabs to secure the pin.
- 3) Attach a 1/4" NPT quick coupler nipple (not provided) into the in-line filter located on the base frame below the tool tray. Use a 1/4" air hose with a supply pressure of <u>no more than 150 psi maximum.</u>





OPERATION

- 1) Rotate the spread hooks out into the upright position.
- 2) Make sure the spreader platform is in the lowest position. If not lower it using the foot pedals.
- 3) Roll the tire up the ramp and onto the platform rollers. Steady the tire with your hand while placing the spread hooks over the tire bead.
- 4) Raise the spreader platform to a comfortable working height using the foot pedals.
- 5) To adjust the spread hooks to the proper height, pull out on the locking pin knob and move the adjustable posts to the correct height. Release the knob and ensure the post is locked. Most large truck tires use the uppermost adjustment hole. Both posts must be adjusted to the same height.
- 6) Spread the tire to the desired width using the hand levers at the rear of the platform. If the tire lifts off the rollers when spread, adjust the posts to a lower position.
- 7) After the tire repairs are complete, lower the platform to its lowest position.
- 8) Release the pressure on the spread arms and lift the hooks out of the tire.
- 9) Steady the tire and roll it down the ramp using both hands.

MAINTENANCE


If maintenance is required, a Locking Key is supplied to hold the platform in the raised position. Keys are located on both sides of the spreader base frame. To use, raise the platform to its highest position and insert the Key into the locked position. The platform will remain in this position when air is disconnected. Do not remove the Key until the air supply is restored. Replace the key in the stored position when maintenance is complete.






